



Equestrian access to restrooms


- Equestrian parking area has no bathroom facilities
 - Nearest easy access is rest room at handicapped trail head
 - Would like ability to tie 1-3 horses
 - For general trail rides
 - For Ridge Cruz lunch activities

Turn around options

- Multiple possibilities with tie rail
 - Use tie rail as fence against first handicapped parking slot shown in green
 - Oriented in middle of turn around, a tie rail
 Shown in Blue
 - Open rocks up to allow Equestrian access into turn around area.
 - Possible addition of large round in place of a few rocks to give mounting pedestal or place for people to sit.

Tie posts along trail Just west of gate and drainage



Tie posts

- Area past gate is wide flat area up against a bank
- Spacing of posts approximately 6 ft apart
- Right 2 are well off of road path, Third is closest to road, but wide area and relatively flat.


Meadow on north side of road



North side of road

- Remove section of railing and allow horses to go to north side of road just into meadow.
 - Use 2 tie rails with opening in between to replace road barrier. This will accommodate up to 4 horses on meadow side out of road way.
 - Keeps turn around free
 - Moves horses away from handicapped area
 - Does open area to meadow
 - Still very close to facilities and activities
 - Add picnic table to turn around
